THE MODERN ART CHAIR 1948

In 1948, Museum of Modern Art hosted a design competition for chairs that should be ready for industrial production and retailed at low prices. This was not exactly Finn Juhl's area of expertise as he had become famous for his incredibly elegant and detailed handcrafted furniture. However, Finn Juhl decided to submit his entry. The result was a beautiful and sculptural armchair in plastic, on which the soft, organic body is seemingly levitating on a base of painted metal legs with wooden toes.
