The Silverware Cabinet

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In 1949, Finn Juhl introduced a cabinet designed for storing silverware that captures some of his most enduring design principles. It was presented at the Cabinetmakers' Guild Exhibition alongside several of his now-iconic pieces. While the Chieftain Chair drew most of the attention, the cabinet itself went largely unnoticed by contemporary critics — despite its striking architectural clarity and refined sense of proportion. The frame is crafted in American walnut, while the cabinet itself is made in Oregon pine.
